# What is it?

- A cross-country research project for mutual learning on Housing First implementation
- It assesses the fidelity of a HF program to the core principles of the original HF model (Pathways to Housing)
- It analyses the different adaptations of the HF model to the different contexts

# Context of the project

- **Housing First is a ground-breaking model**
  - Shakes mindsets
  - Questions existing intervention models
  - That always scares and generates reluctances
- **Development of HF at international level**
  - Early introduction stage in many countries
  - Different countries = different policy, social & health services contexts
  - Many different organizations will implement HF programs
- **HF is born as an evidence based practice**
  - Evaluation shows programs deliver results on expected outcomes
  - We need to know what are we evaluating
- **International community around HF**
  - Shared knowledge and mutual learning

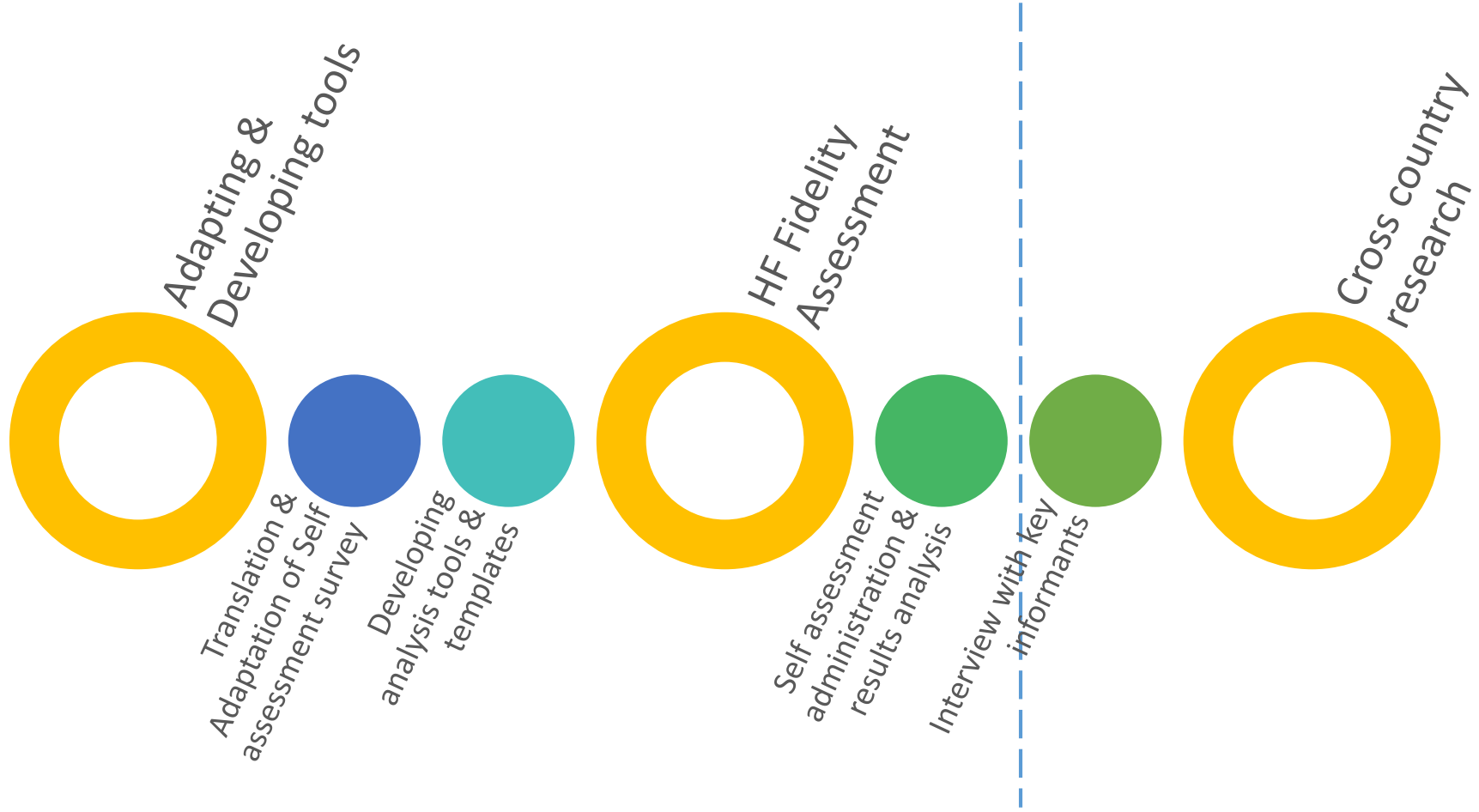

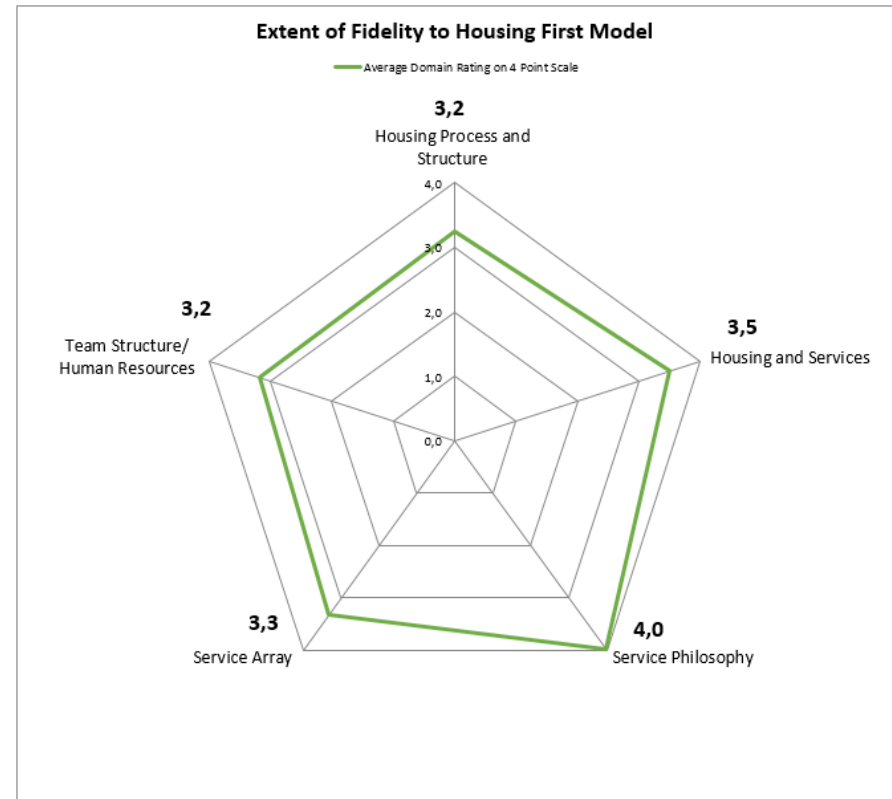

# Interview with key informants (QUAL)

Conducted individually or in a group with program managers and service providers

Parts of the interview:

## 1) Items with low scoring

- Which are the barriers?
- Which ways to move forward?

## 2) Drivers, obstacles, challenges

- Go through other identified issues relevant to the program success or needed from improvement
